Paper statements will not be sent to any owner of the account.
- Opt Out – If you choose to Opt Out and stop online-only statement delivery, paper statements will be provided, and your account may be subject to certain other provisions set forth in the rules applicable to such account. Fees for paper statements apply for deposit accounts and are disclosed in our [Schedule of Fees and Charges](#).

We may elect to terminate some or all of the eDelivery Service or charge you certain fees if you choose to receive Communications in paper or non-electronic form. Please also see the [Terms and Conditions of Your Account](#).

- In order to use our **eDelivery Service**, you will need a working connection to the Internet using one of the supported Internet browsers listed on the Mechanics Bank website and a login to our online banking service.
